AGROECOLOGY SUMMER PROGRAM

SCHOOL TEACHERS & STUDENTS

SCHOOL TEACHERS: A five-day summer workshop covering advances in agro-ecological issues, bioenergy and biotechnology by experts from FIU, USDA, other agencies and farmers. Workshop includes in-house lectures at FIU and traveling to biofuels plantations within south/central Florida. Participant compensation (\$250 each) is paid. Please email a one-page statement, indicating what impact your participation at the workshop would have on your teaching program, and a recommendation letter from your supervisor. Program Runs from June 9-13th.

HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS: A paid (\$500) eight week internship for high school students to gain hands on experience in FIU faculty labs or field sites in South Florida, including their high school yards on problems related to agri-sciences. Submit a project idea, college and career goal, resume, teacher's recommendation, high school transcript, and SAT scores. Program Runs from June 9-July 18th, 2014.

MSP SCHOLARSHIP: Up to four-year college scholarship of \$26,000 to pursue a degree in Environmental Studies (or relevant degree) at FIU, with a focus on agroecology sciences.
