### Agroecology Program

Florida International University's Department of Earth and Environment offers FIVE scholarships to qualified students to pursue a BS in Environmental Studies with a focus on Agroecology. It offers an 18-credit hour Agroecology Certificate Program, supports student travel and research, conducts Agroecology related and professional development workshops, summer internships, field tours, and job placement assistance. Students receive up to \$26,000 in funding throughout their scholarship term to support for time spent in experiential and experimental based learning.

Interested high school seniors may send their application packet with the following documents:

- Resume
- A cover letter- 500 word statement of intent explaining why you are interested in this scholarship (make sure to include any prior experience in food and agriculture science)
- Two letters of recommendation
- A copy of your high school transcript and SAT score



Engage in lab research, internship & service learning projects

Eligibility: minority students and students of multi-cultural background are preferred; high school cumulative unweighted GPA of 2.7 and a combined SAT score of 1800 (under the new system).
